

(13~15 分)

完全符合题目要求, 表达思想清楚且积极向上, 内容丰富。使用多种句型结构和丰富的词汇, 语言通顺, 语意连贯, 具有逻辑性和交际性。

第二档: (9~12 分)

基本符合题目要求, 表达思想基本清楚, 内容完整。语法结构和词汇基本满足 文章需要。语言基本通顺, 语意基本连贯。有少量语言错误, 但不影响整体理解。

第三档: (5~8 分)

部分内容符合题目要求, 表达思想不够清楚, 内容不够完整。语法结构和词汇错误较多, 语言不通顺, 影响整体理解。

第四档: (0~4 分)

与题目有关内容不多, 只是简单拼凑提示词语, 所写内容难以理解。
